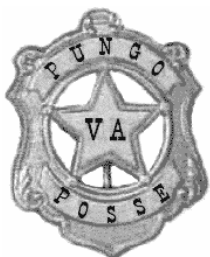

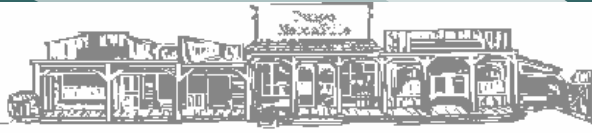


The Pungo Posse Badge

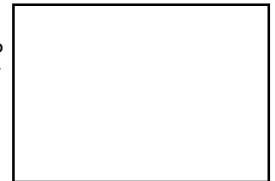

Pungo Posse's Range Rules - 2004

F) **All Shooters:** All shooters in the shooting area are safety officers. Anyone observing a safety violation should bring the violation to the attention of the RO immediately after the shooter has completed the stage.

Everyone is expected to pay attention to what is going on at the firing line. It is expected and required that we conduct ourselves in an orderly manner and remain quiet while a shooter is firing a stage.

4) **HANDLING, LOADING AND UNLOADING FIREARMS.** All firearms are to remain unloaded at all times unless you are loading at a supervised loading table or by command of a range officer while on the firing line. The following safety rules shall be in effect at all times during a match.

A) **Treat all firearms as loaded and point in a safe direction at all times.**

B) **There will be no handling of firearms except:** when removing them from or returning them to your vehicle, bringing them to the designated storage area; when preparing to shoot by bringing them to the loading table; actual shooting on the firing line; carrying them to the unloading table and storing firearms immediately after shooting a stage; or in an area set aside specifically for that purpose. All Long guns will be carried with the barrel pointed vertically or downrange at all times. **Violation will constitute a Minor Safety Violation, and result in a ten (+10) second pen-**

alty. Sweeping any one with an unloaded firearm will result in a Stage DQ. Rifles and shotguns will be stored unloaded with actions open in a gun rack or shooters cart when not in use on the firing line. Pistols will remain holstered or cased when not in use. Handguns must be holstered when the person is moving, no loaded handguns other than at the loading table or on the firing line. **Violation of this rule will result in a Stage DQ.** "Show and Tell", It has been noticed that there is always someone wanting to look at (handle) a shooters firearms. Due to SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS this will be Allowed Only On The Firing Line Or Loading Table Before The Start Of The Main Match Or After The Main Match Has Been Concluded, Or In An Area Designated / Set Aside Specifically For That Purpose By The Posse Director.

C) **Shooters using cap and ball revolvers.** The end of the loading table closest to the unloading table is the only appropriate place to charge C&B Revolvers. However, at times the Posse Director may designate an area just for use only by cap & ball shooters for charging. Competitors choosing to use percussion revolvers may load and cap only five chambers. After charging they will be left UNCAPPED until the shooter is called to the loading table in preparation to shoot the stage. They may be carried holstered & UNCAPPED in the shooting area after being charged. When the stage shooting instructions call for a one shot reload (example: load one round anytime after firing the first shot) the C&B revolver shooter will load all six chambers with the hammer down on the sixth charged, but uncapped chamber, the sixth chamber will be capped on the clock then the shooter will began the course of fire. A five shot cap and ball revolver may load and cap only four chambers with the hammer down on the fifth charged, but uncapped chamber. The fifth chamber is capped on the clock. A complete reload is handled by staging a loaded, uncapped revolver down range or switching loaded uncapped cylinders, and capping on the clock.

Bullets

I'm looking into buying bullets from Bonus Bullets. They offer a large variety of calibers, bullet weights and sizes all in high quality. They also offer a discount on both the price and shipping charges for clubs that buy in bulk. The more we buy the better the discount. The prices will not be as good as the ones we enjoyed with D&J Bullets before they went out of business.

Anyone interested in making a group bullet buy let me know what you want (caliber, type, size, etc.) and the quantity you want. We'll need to order large quantities with a minimum group order of 5,000 bullets per order. An order of 10,000 or more bullets would be better in order to save more on both bullet price and shipping prices. The larger the order the better the prices. As before this will have to be a cash up front before the order goes in deal. Check out their web page "www.bonusbullets.com" for bullet type, caliber, size diameter and prices that they offer.

SASS

In anticipation of getting a new larger range where we can handle a larger number of cowboys, have permanent store fronts, and hold yearly matches. I have contacted SASS in regards to Club Affiliation for the posse. This won't change the way we hold our matches nor any club rules we have that are contrary to SASS Rules. It will mean that any large yearly match we hold will be a SASS Sanctioned Match.

A few thoughts : from Southpaw

In September we're planning on shooting a **"6-Stage" match - weather permitting, if it's HOT & Humid we'll stop at 4 stages. For those who want to know how many rounds of ammo to bring to the match, Pistol 60, Rifle 55, & Shotgun 24.** Bring a few more than that, it never hurts ta have extra , ***ya might need'em fer a re-shoot.*** We'll be using our new knockdown shotgung targets. Plan on it being a

hot to real hot day with temperature from 80 to 99 degrees, check the weather report and dress accordingly. Mrs. Southpaw will have , water and cold lemonade to quench your thirst. **Don't forget to bring a lunch.** After the match join us at Frankie's Place for Ribs on Kempsville Road for supper. Bring your better half along (she gets hungry too) and enjoy some good

food. Be ready to have some fun and enjoy some cowboy fellowship.

Due to the size of our range, the number of shooters at a match is limited to 75, (3 posse setup, 50+ w/ 2 posse setup). Shooters will be registered on a first come first served basis. New shooters must watch one match before they can participate unless they are a SASS member or member of a CAS club and compete in cow-

boy action match's elsewhere.

The Pungo Posse is a Single Action Shooting Society affiliated Cowboy Action Shooting Club. SASS Rules are our Rules with a few listed exceptions, Pungo Posse Rules Will Apply At All Monthly Matches.

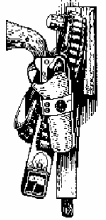
